III. Targeted Students

Multiple measures are used to determine student needs: Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA2), state testing results, Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment results, Read Well assessments, classroom assessments, and teacher recommendations

IV. Supports Offered

Reading Specialist support (K-5); before/after school academic support; small intervention groups; supportive website subscriptions

V. Federal Requirements

Opportunities for parental involvement (policy, compact, meetings, trainings, advisory committee); progress reported to parents
